

ChatGPT: Distraction, Disruption, or Defining Moment?

Kimberly Tatman Director of Teaching and Learning Chadwick School (CA) With the language-generative AI tools recently making headlines around the world, educators are at a critical moment in the evolution of educational technology. This session will begin with an overview of how Chadwick School (CA) has approached this important topic at this point, including regional and national conversations with academic leaders beyond our school and an explicit focus on both short-term needs and long-term innovation. We will share how we gathered input to establish and grow buy-in for consistent usage policies to foster clarity and equity while the school prepares to engage in more strategic conversations about how emerging technologies can be a catalyst for instructional improvement.
